The Marine Center is a wonderful place for youth to have hands-on experience learning about our precious environment and understand how to become stewards for our ocean and marine life.






We have been leading cleanups for over 10 years to maintain our beautiful beaches for Long Islanders and visitors to enjoy for years to come.
